
We are reading

Mathematics Year 1




Mathematics EYFS

We will kick off our mathematics by further developing our understanding of place value to 100. We will count from 50 to 100 and practise partitioning numbers into tens and ones. Later in the term, we will look at time where we will learn days of the week, months of the year and will learn to tell the time to the hour and to the half hour. more less compare hours minutes seconds

EYFS will begin mathematics by exploring sharing and grouping. We will look at even and odd sharing and practise building doubles.












Science




Geography

We will become Geography Wonderers as we explore the different cities of the United Kingdom. We will name, locate and identify characteristics of the four capital cities of the UK and its surrounding seas. We will enjoy developing our skills as we use atlases and compass directions to describe the location of features on a map.

For the final part of the year, we will explore 'My World, Jesus' World.' We will look at how the place where Jesus lived is different from the place we live now. •	Jesus lived a long time ago (over 2000 years) and the world we live in is very different to Jesus' world
•	Jesus was Jewish not Christian
•	Jesus attended the Synagogue
*	some of Jesus' life experiences were just like ours. Therefore Christians believe Jesus the Son of God knows exactly what life is like for us.
*	Jesus celebrated Jewish Festivals e.g. Passover
By the end of this unit pupils are expected to be able to:	
•	talk confidently about their own life and experiences.
•	talk confidently about the Jewish features of Jesus' life.
•	talk about what they find puzzling or interesting.
*	talk about the similarities and differences between our world and Jesus' world using Bible stories to illustrate.
*	recognise that some foods have special symbolic meaning in religious practice.




PHSE




